Subject:- Pre-Bid Meeting regarding Hiring of Equipment (HoE) works at Gadegaon OCM of Wani Area (E-TENDER No. 13/2026-27 (GEM/2026/B/7564648))

Venue: 3rd Floor Conference Room, WCL HQ, Nagpur (Hybrid Mode)

Chaired by: Director (Technical)/WCL

At the outset, Director(Technical),WCL welcomed all the participants and GM (CMC), WCL explained the technical details of Gadegaon Mine, Wani Area and complete scope of work as per bid document/NIT was appraised to the prospective bidders through Power Point Presentation, providing a brief overview of the HoE proposal.

Key Discussion Points and Suggestions:

- Bidders raised a query regarding the site/project hindrances & time-bound resolution.
- GM, Wani Area, apprised the bidders there are in total 5 nos. of critical activities identified to be taken up prior to start of the work by the L-1 bidder and the same shall be resolved timely by WCL management.
- Bidders sought clarification regarding the land to be possessed is forest land or tenancy land.
- GM, Wani Area, apprised the bidders that land to be possessed is tenancy land.
- Bidders sought clarification regarding the status of land required for dumping.
- GM, Wani Area, apprised the bidders that existing land of Penganga OCM is used for backfilling OB in the balance decoaled void area with merging & heightening with existing OB dumps of Penganga OCM to accommodate the OB of proposed Gadegaon OCM.
- Further, Sri. Pawan Maheshwari, Senior Manager (Min/ CMC), explained the various common errors typically made by the prospective bidders during bid submission on GeM portal, advising them on best practices to avoid such technical or procedural mistakes in this tender as well as in future tenders in order to avoid rejection of bids during technical evaluation.
- D(T), WCL specifically reiterated the common errors generally made by bidders and advised them to submit their bids only after thoroughly going through the GeM bid document/NIT.
- Further, the bidders were advised that any query with respect to GeM Bid No. GEM/2026/B/7564648, may be sought through e-mail from the office of GM (CMC), WCL.

The Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC) have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of their Competent Authority. The Buyer, is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and including the modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. All representations / grievances pertaining to the ATC clauses shall be raised with the buyer organization directly and not with GeM. If any of the clause(s) is/are incorporated by the Buyer regarding the following, the bid & resultant contract shall be treated as null & void. Further, GeM reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel the bid forthwith, without issuance of any prior notice or intimation :-

1. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available (unless such Custom / BOQ item is bunched with the major regular product Category Item).
2. Mandating procurement of / from specific Brand / Make / Model / Manufacturer / Dealer except in case of Single Bid / Proprietary Article Certificate (PAC) Buying.
3. Inclusion of disqualification criteria related to suspension of seller / service provider, where such suspension period has already expired.
4. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
5. Publishing bids on GeM for procurement of works.
6. Procurement of Goods by creating a Service bid on GeM & vice-versa.
